Project Updates

Desert Springs: ZTEX has completed material import and is currently working on balancing the site in preparation for final grading.

Haymon Krupp: We are currently awaiting the revised civil drawing changes before remobilization. Once remobilized, ZTEX will begin installation of 4" backflow prevent or (CC03).

Jail Annex: ZTEX is working on the final grading and clean up.

Santa Teresa Giant: We are currently working on the cut to fill. ZTEX will continue to install screenings at the 5-acre site.

FedEx Ground: We are currently working on the cut to fill. ZTEX is also getting ready to install building pads on the base course and will begin working on the storm sewer pipe.

Desert Sky: ZTEX is currently working on subgrade preparation and concrete sidewalks.

City Storage: We are currently working on completing curb and gutter.

Chicken Xpress: We are currently working on rough site grading.

Manny Aguilera HWY: ZTEX will continue with Ty C embankment. We are approximately 25% complete with the project.

Western Dairy: ZTEX is taking care of punch list items and project completion within the next couple of weeks.
