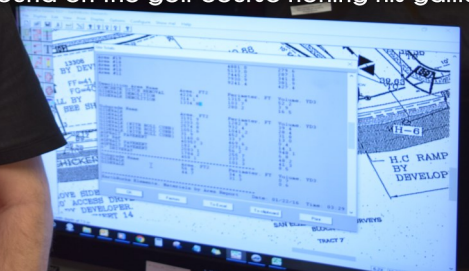

Wednesday, February 17th, Pope Francis will visit the El Paso-Juárez area for the first time in history. The pontiff will fly into Juárez and is expected to visit Cereso prison, meet with workers and then celebrate a Mass at the border. Some 450,000 people from both sides of the border are expected to be at the Mass to be held at the Juárez fairgrounds and on streets along the route to his stops in the city, officials have said.

Project Updates

Tornillo Manny F. Aguilera Highway: ZTEX is to do all earthwork and base course and is currently working on preparing right of way.

Haymon Krupp Apartments: ZTEX is to complete all civil work including utilities, earthwork, paving, and concrete. Completed 80% of over-excavation operations.

MCS Warehouse: ZTEX is currently working on asphalt, paving, and final grading. It is projected to be done in a month.

Jail Annex: ZTEX is working on the North side sidewalks leading into the North parking lot. It is projected to be completed in March.

4Rivers/John Deere: About 90% of the final grading is complete; the storm drain operations are yet to be commenced. We will be back in a month after the vertical walls are erected.

Skyview Estates: All curb and gutter, water lines, and sanitary sewer work are complete.

Las Torres: ZTEX just finished completing all punch list items.

Desert Sky: ZTEX is currently working on the storm drain and will be starting utility work within the month.

Montecillo 4A: ZTEX is currently placing curb and gutter. We have completed sanitary sewer, domestic water and stormdrain.

Western Dairy: 85% complete on earthwork. Will be finishing earthwork in mid-March to finish earthwork and paving.

La Villita: We are continuing work on TXDOT ROW, paved deceleration lanes, and will begin all concrete site work. We have begun laying base course in three separate areas and will start to work on the curb adjacent to the concrete pavement.

Desert Pass Apartments: Working on the fire line for fire hydrants, laid concrete header curb around buildings.

North Hills Crossing Phase II: Finished regrading and repaving the grading bust at storefronts. Connected water services from water meters to the back of the buildings. Will begin laying the base course at the backside of the buildings.
