Job Site Highlight Of The Month: Horizon Town Center



ZTEX has recently started the Horizon Town Center project with Miguel Luna as Superintendent and Ezri Navarro as Project Manager. We have just begun work on the water, storm, and sewer pipelines, and expect to finish in 90 days. Miguel had all required paperwork for a surprise Safety Inspection. He is noted to be very detailed in all his work, including the Daily Trenching records, Equipment Inspection reports, Training records, and Daily Equipment reports. Project Manager Ezri Navarro says Miguel is a problem solver and always looks for solutions before informing management of an issue. Safety Director Daniel Esparaza says this project has just started, and it already looks promising. Keep up the good team work, organized tactics, and the indispensable attitudes.

Project Updates

Horizon Towne Center: We began site work earlier this month and are currently working on installing pipelines.

West Towne Marketplace: We have completed storm lines A & B and water line A. We are continuing work on storm lines D & F and sanitary sewer line A.

Montecillo: Continuing earthwork on units Montecillo 4B & 5B.

Desert Pass Apartments: ZTEX has completed all work on this project.

Haymon Krupp: All work has been promptly completed, ending on a positive note.

North Loop Apartments: We have completed installation of sanitary sewer line and water line, and we expect to finish rock wall and storm sewer line in the next few weeks.

FedEx Ground Warehouse: This month we have completed asphalt paving and are continuing work on perimeter drains.

Santa Teresa Giant: We are completing additional chain-link fence extensions and changes to the entry gate. We aim to finish by the end of the month.
