#### Long-Term Exposure (Exposición a Largo Plazo)

- · Fumes may cause lung & stomach cancer (Los gases pueden causar cáncer de pulmón y estómago)
- Skin rash or burns (Sarlullido o guernaduras en la piel)
- Fatigue (Fatiga)
- Eye & throat irritation (Irritación de los ojos y la garganta)

### Sources of Ignition (Fuentes de Ignición)

- · Asphalt has high oil concentration (El asfalto tiene una alta concentración de aceite)
- Keep sparks, flames, & cigarettes away (Mantenga chispas, llamas y cigarrillos lejos)
- · Have a fire extinguisher available for possible fires (Tener un extintor de incendios disponible para posibles incendios)

#### High Temperatures (from 270°F up-to325°F) (Temperaturas altas (270°F hasta 325°F)

- Use Protective gear to avoid burns (Use equipo de protección para evitar quemad-
- Long sleeve shirts & long pants (Camisas de manga larga y pantalones largos)
- Thermal gloves & boots (Guantes térmicos y botas)
- Safety goggles (Face shield with highly corrosive asphalt) (Gafas de seguridad [protector facial con asfalto altamente corrosivo])

### Spotter Safety (Seguridad de Observador)

- Keep eye-contact with the driver (Mantener contacto visual con el conductor)
- Do not get in between dump-truck and asphalt paver (No permanesca en medio de el camión de volteo y la extendedora de asfalto)
- Direct driver when backing up (Dirija al conductor al dirijiose en reversa)
- Be aware of overhead power lines before driver lifts truck bed (Tenga en cuenta las líneas eléctricas aéreas antes de que el conductor levante la cama del camión)
