## **Project Updates**

**West Towne Marketplace:** ZTEX is currently working on curb & gutter on all parking lots and base placements.

**Montecillo Unit 11:** We are continuing cut & fill on site, and we will soon begin storm sewer installation.

**Montecillo Unit 5B:** We have begun installing water lines and are almost done with storm drains.

**Montecillo Unit 4B:** ZTEX is currently testing the water line, and we will soon begin installation of water services.

**Sky View Estates Phase II:** We have installed all utilities, and we are currently working on curb & gutter.

**Street Resurfacing 2015:** ZTEX has completed asphalt paving at Ingersoll Way, Alabama St. & Grant Ave. and we are currently working on Meril Rd.

**Street Resurfacing 2017:** We have completed asphalt paving at Alaska St. & Hawaii St. and are currently doing ramp, curb & gutter, and sidewalk concrete at Lee Blvd. from Montwood Dr. to Pebble Hills Blvd.

**North Loop Apartments:** ZTEX is currently working on sidewalks, curb & gutter, and paving around the buildings.

**Horizon Town Center:** We have completed Storm Sewer line installation, and we are currently testing the sanitary sewer lines.

**Paving of Unpaved Rights-of-Way:** We have completed first two alleys at Fort Blvd. & N. Copia St. and will continue work per schedule.
