Project Updates

Sky View Estates Phase II: Site grade and ponding area are 95% complete. We have completed all the installation of the curb and gutter, sanitary sewer, water and storm lines.

Montecillo Unit 11: Currently, continuing the cut to fill activities and have begun installation of the storm sewer.

Montecillo 5B: Storm sewer has been completed, working on new additions to future buildings. Water main distribution line will be finalized this week, and we will continue work on water services and hydrants.

Montecillo Unit 9 (4B) East: We completed sanitary sewer and water distribution line and services on 5/3/17. Currently installing curb and gutter on the perimeter roads and will commence base course installation next week.

Montecillo Unit 9 (4B) West: Currently installing sanitary sewer distribution line on the perimeter roads.

North Loop Apartments: ZTEX has installed curb and gutter, processed subgrade, installed base course and paved with asphalt around building 1, 2 and club house.

Horizon Town Center: Sanitary sewer line, distribution, and services has been completed.

Paving of Unpaved Right of Ways: We have completed two alleys on Copia and Fort. Currently finishing the base course on three alleys on Stevens and Nashville, and will commence paving next week.

West Towne Marketplace: Utilities (storm, water & sewer) are 95% complete. Original rock retaining walls are 100% complete. Curb & Gutter on parking lot islands is 100% complete. Overall grading is 95% complete, only pending select fill in shops and on fire lanes. All site work, including paving and striping, to be completed by the beginning of August.

Wal-Mart at West Towne Marketplace: Project began Monday 04/17/17 and over-excavation completed on 04/24/17. Select fill material placement completed in 16 working days. Currently working on the fine grade pads and will have the pad elevations certified by Professional Surveyor.

Street Resurfacing 2015: Finished asphalt paving on N Clark Dr. (between El Paso Dr. and Alameda Ave). Currently working on removal of noncompliance ADA ramps at Honolulu Dr., from Montwood Dr. to Leewood Dr., New Handicap ramps are being installed.

Street Resurfacing 2017: Currently working on removal of noncompliance ADA ramps, sidewalk, curb & gutter at Lee Blvd. from Montwood Dr. to Pebble Hills. New Handicap ramps are currently being installed.
