


Cutting Edge Technology

Photogrammetry ZTEX Construction, Inc. successfully launched its first use of 3D Photogrammetry. This technology uses photographs to detect and measure the distance between points on a terrain. The technology records 3D motion fields, renders 3D mapping, generates a report and provides a Digital Elevation Model (DEM). Using Photogrammetry will save us time and money when surveying our projects. Three months in, we have succeeded with mapping Montecillo West Unit 11/ Topgolf location. Utilizing Photogrammetry, the survey of the 125-acre site went from taking three weeks, to only three days. Project Updates

Sky View Estates Phase II: Site grade has been completed and all utilities have been installed. We will return to site to continue paving.

Montecillo Unit 11: Currently, continuing installation of storm sewer.

Montecillo 5B: Water main distribution line has been finalized and we are currently installing the sanitary sewer services.

Montecillo Unit 9 (4B) East: Curb & gutter and paving on the perimeter roads has been completed.

Montecillo Unit 9 (4B) West: Currently installing sanitary sewer distribution line on the perimeter roads.

Horizon Town Center: We have completed sanitary sewer, water line, and storm drain services.

Paving of Unpaved Right of Ways: We have completed the second section of alleys on Stevens and Nashville and have begun work on third section of alleys between Truman & Lincoln from Partello & Byron.

West Towne Marketplace: We are continuing fine grading on areas left to pave (shops, parking lot, fire lanes) and we have completed 50% of asphalt paving on entire site.

Wal-Mart at West Towne Marketplace: We are currently constructing over-excavation of site loading docks.

Street Resurfacing 2015: We have begun paving intersection at Pullman and Rojas, and we are scheduled to finish paving at Honolulu St. by the end of the month.

Street Resurfacing 2017: We are currently working on ADA ramps, non-compliant sidewalks, driveways, curb & gutter concrete work at Granite Rd. and Coconut Tree Rd.
