- Pre-use inspection is to ensure the machine is safe to operate. La inspección previa al uso es para garantizar que la máquina funcione con seguridad.
- A defective machine could easily endanger the life of its operator, as well as the lives of laborers working in close proximity to it.

Project Updates

Topgolf at Montecillo: ZTEX has completed rough grading and we will begin with the base course.

Montecillo Unit 11: We have partially finished the storm sewer installation and we have begun the sanitary sewer lines.

Montecillo Unit 9 (4B): We complete with water & sewer services and we are installing the curb & gutter.

Montecillo 5B: ZTEX has began installing 12" waterline.

Horizon Town Center: We have completed all major site work.

Paving of Unpaved Right of Ways: We have completed base course and concrete work, and we are ready to begin paving between Truman and Lincoln.

Skyview Estates Phase II: We have completed final grade and we will begin paving.

North Loop Apartments: ZTEX is 90% complete on concrete sidewalks and curb & gutter.

West Towne Marketplace: All site work has been completed as scheduled.

Wal-Mart at West Towne Marketplace: ZTEX has began excavation for storm services and concrete footing for rock wall.

Street Resurfacing 2015: All work has been finalized.

Street Resurfacing 2017: We are currently working on ADA ramps, sidewalks, curb & gutter at Abraham St.

Howdy's Gas Station at Pellicano: We are continuing water services, which consists on installing fire hydrants.

Petsmart at Joe Battle: Sanitary sewer line installation has been completed and we are currently installing the water line.

3D Photogrammetry Model

The latest Photogrammetry model ZTEX is working on is the completed West Towne Marketplace project. So far we have

rendered an aerial view of the entire site and have begun working on 3D models of the buildings, Cabela's, the first to be released.
