Howdy's Gas Station at Pellicano: We have completed all utilities and have begun curb & gutter.

Petsmart at Joe Battle: ZTEX has completed curb & gutter and have begun asphalt paving.

TGS/One Gas: We are continuing concrete & asphalt repairs at Block Projects near Piedras St.
